Desjarlais provided an update to the committee about his communications with UBC surrounding the campus evacuation and affected students.

Desjarlais outlined that 400 students had been evacuated from campus and that those that did not opt for a hotel are in good care at Prospera Place downtown. He additionally outlined that nearly 600 students have requested funds from UBC's Emergency Relief subsidy. Desjarlais stated additionally that all on-campus activities have been cancelled and that although the evacuation order has been rescinded, UBC is encouraging students to stay off of campus.

Desjarlais asked the Executive Committee to work on reallocating funds.

It was determined that five thousand (\$5000) dollars be moved from the General Manager's budget for Christmas and Birthdays. One thousand (\$1000) would be brought in from leftover funds from BCFS travel and SUDS as well as four thousand (\$4000) dollars from the conferences line in general.
